## OUR ONGOING PROJECTS

**Little Hearts Surgery :** We provide vital financial support for paediatric surgeries required by underprivileged children suffering from congenital heart defects. Each life-saving operation costs approximately Rs. 1.2 lakhs. To date, we have successfully funded 48 surgeries and aim to complete an additional 42 surgeries to give more children a chance at a healthy life.

**Plastic Surgery :** This program facilitates free surgical camps for the correction of cleft palates, facial deformities, and burn injuries among underprivileged patients. We provide sponsorship support for a specialized team of doctors and nurses from Germany, who conduct approximately 100 surgeries each year during their February visit to the Jalna Hospital.

**Eye camps & Cataract surgery :** Launched in 2019-20, this ongoing initiative provides free cataract surgeries to underprivileged individuals. We partner with designated hospitals where renowned doctors volunteer their services to meet community needs. To date, we have successfully performed 553 free cataract surgeries for needy patients.

**KGVM- Nilaya Sukoon Palliative Care Project :** During the COVID-19 pandemic, the King George V Memorial Trust (KGVM) took a pioneering step to establish "Sukoon Nilaya", a Palliative Care Centre dedicated to treating patients suffering from life-limiting illnesses other than cancer. This initiative is the first of its kind in Maharashtra. It provides free-of-cost compassionate care, counselling, and care-giver support. Our mission is to ensure dignity, comfort and quality of life for patients in their final journey, while also training healthcare professionals and caregivers in palliative care practices

**NHSRCC Paediatric Oncology Project :** This initiative aims to support 10–12 children suffering from cancer every year, providing complete treatment assistance under the Patient Support Program. The support offered is towards surgery in children suffering from solid tumours mainly of the brain and kidney. Each child's surgery averages around Rs. 2,00,000. SRCC's outcomes are outstanding with 80% of critically-ill children recovering fully.

**NICU renovation at Aastha Hospital, Palghar :** The project is to provide a new neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) for newborns in the tribal district of Palghar serving the tribal villages in that region of Maharashtra. This life-saving medical infrastructure would critically-ill neonates free inhouse.

**Health Check-up Camps :** We conduct Free Medical Camps and provide comprehensive health and nutrition education. These services are designed for the evaluation, early detection, and prevention of common medical conditions among two key groups: youth in schools and colleges and societal guardians such as the Police force. Health camps for breast-screening is also conducted regularly.

**E- Learning :** This initiative digitally equips BMC school classrooms and provides comprehensive teacher training to integrate technology effectively. The primary goal is to enhance learning and teaching methodologies using the necessary languages.

**Ummeed :** To ensure children with developmental disabilities are integrated into society, we offer vital therapeutic services. These include speech therapy, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, and mental health counselling. This is aimed at maximizing their developmental potential.

**Kamla Mehta School for the Blind :** We provide overall support through social development initiatives and specialized medical camps to ensure that blind students receive comprehensive and adequate care across health and social parameters.

**Annamrita: Midday meal school program :** For the past 15 years, our club has championed the Annamrita initiative in coordination with the ISKCON Food Relief Foundation. This project provides nutritious meals to underprivileged children, ensuring their optimum physical and mental development. To date, this vital program has successfully fed thousands of individuals.

**NASEOH :** For over four decades, this project has been a beacon of inclusivity and community enrichment, dedicated to supporting differently-abled individuals. We focus on rehabilitation and leveraging their unique abilities to help shape a truly inclusive world.

**Waste - Coastal cleaning project at Alibaug :** This initiative turns the challenge of marine pollution into opportunity by employing local Alibaug villagers in the collection and recycling of ocean waste. The project specifically focuses on empowering and providing sustained employment to women in the surrounding villages, reinforcing the concept that all materials can be valued.

**Vocational Guidance :** A project in collaboration with the NGO Masoom with the aim of empowering need-based individuals, especially the youth with practical skills to improve employability and self-reliance. It provides Computer-literacy with future plans to include English language training and other skill development

**Cyber-crime safety :** A project in collaboration with an NGO Brush of Hope with the mission to educate, empower and protect children, parents and educators from the dangers of cyber-bullying, sextortion and online exploitation. A vision to make a safe, inclusive and supportive digital world.

**School infra-structure at Utawali Village, Maharashtra :** The Adarsh Vidyalyaya High School in the area for tribal children is a co-educational school with a student strength of 600 students from grade 5 to 10 taught in Semi-English and Marathi. In the last few years, A comprehensive renovation of 10 classrooms is underway along with the school compound and gate ensuring safety and security of students.

**Corpus Fund of Rotary Club of Bombay Mid-Town :** Given our commitment to working across all areas of the community, our general fund needs replenishment to ensure the continuation of all programs and services.
